Alice Anne is an accomplished community leader and innovator, having served most recently as Director of Education for the Harrisburg Symphony. In addition Ms. Schwab has an extensive history of connection to the Greater Harrisburg community. She currently serves on the boards of the Children’s Home Foundation, the East Shore YMCA, and on the Board of Trustees of Market Square Presbyterian Church.

Alice Anne Schwab’s appointment as Executive Director for the Susquehanna Art Museum (SAM) comes at a pivotal time for the Museum. The Susquehanna Art Museum, officially opened to the public in January 2015, exhibits nationally and internationally recognized artists to educate, inspire and foster creative exploration, collaboration and public engagement.
